Credits from the GCTL (Doctorate) are transferable to BGU's Doctorate in Transformational Leadership (DTL) Program. Admission

- Those applying for the GCTL (Masters) must have completed a minimum Bachelor's Degree
- Those applying for the GCTL (Doctorate) must have completed a postgraduate Masters degree (preferably MBA) and have at least 10 years of management experience.

International Students

- Proof of English proficiency may be required for international students
 - TOEFL Required Scores:
 - Paper-based = 550 points
 - Computer-based = 213 points
 - Internet-based = 78 points
 - IELTS Required Score: 6



The Curriculum

The 12-credit GCLT comprises 12 credits of core modules. Masters level students will take four courses at 3-credit hours each while Doctoral level students will take three courses at 4-credit hours each. The following are the modules available under the GCTL.
